Whether your company is looking to move into an existing office or would like to build new, the Greater Wichita region offers low commercial lease rates and construction costs that fall below national averages.

Compare the Costs of Doing Business

- All business equipment purchases are 100% property tax exempt.
- Kansas had **the 7th lowest industrial natural gas total delivered cost among the 50 states** in 2020 at \$3.38 per MCF (MM BTU) (U.S. Energy Information Administration)
- Energy commercial rates in the Wichita area are 7.3% lower than the national average. (C2ER COLI; 2022-Q1)
- Wichita area **industrial space average asking rent is 32% below the national average at \$4.78/SF per year** compared to the national metro average asking rent: \$7.01/SF per year (Q1-2018) (32% below national average)
- Wichita area Class A office space average asking rent is 40% below national average at \$19.39/SF per year compared to the national metro average rent: \$32.43/SF per year (Q1-2018)
- Wichita's April 2018 Means Commercial Construction Cost Index was 11.5% below the national average with a rating of 88.5.
