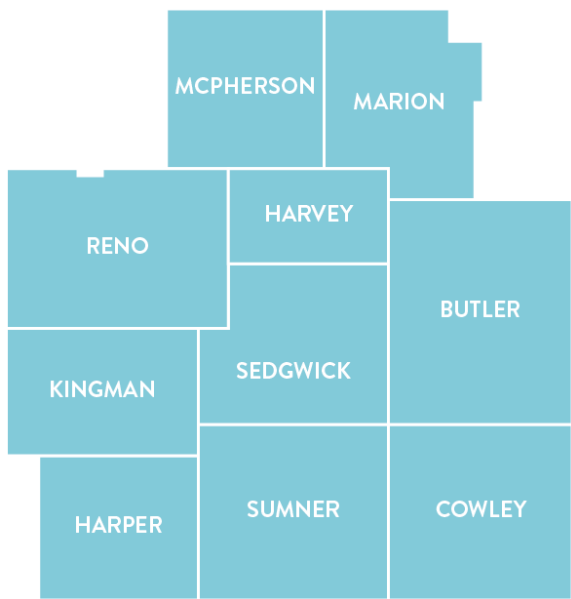




EXPLORE THE GREATER WICHITA REGION
