Wichita, Kan. – To celebrate the 450+ aviation businesses that make the greater Wichita region the Air Capital of the world, the Greater Wichita Partnership will lead a delegation of 16 companies and organizations to the 2019 National Business Aviation Association (NBAA) Business Aviation Convention & Exhibition (BACE) in Las Vegas, Nevada on October 22 – 24.

NBAA-BACE is the one of the largest tradeshow in the United States and provides the platform to promote the Wichita region – named the Air Capital of the World – capabilities to over 23,000 aircraft owners, industry professionals, manufacturers and customers.

The Air Capital of the World delivers 35% of all general aviation in the nation, boasts a 450+ supplier network and the #4 manufacturing workforce in the U.S.
