DOWNTOWN WICHITA *Clean Team*

Beginning Feb. 1, 2026, Downtown Wichita's Clean Team transitioned from a pilot into a fully professionalized program managed by Block by Block, a national leader in place management. Backed by increased SSMID investment, the program expands to three full-time Ambassadors and one part-time Ambassador, includes enhanced equipment, and data-driven reporting to ensure measurable cleanliness, responsiveness and accountability.
