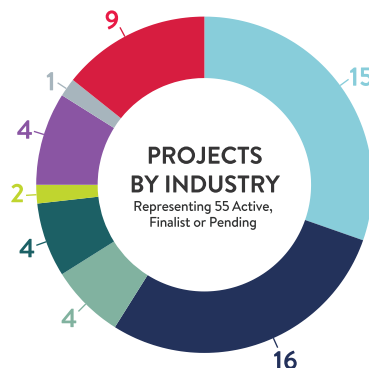

TALENT TALK BIOMED INDUSTRY AND EDUCATION: A HEALTHCARE REVOLUTION IN OUR REGION

In March 2025, 70 leaders from education and industry attended a Talent Talk focused on anticipated changes in the ecosystem as a result of the new biomedical campus in Downtown Wichita. To meet the workforce needs of the future in the biomedical industry, the campus plans to:

- Graduate more than 1,000 new healthcare providers each year.
- Train more than 2,500 students each year, with capacity to grow.
- Promote access to clinical trials in Kansas.

Two more Talent Talks are planned in 2025.



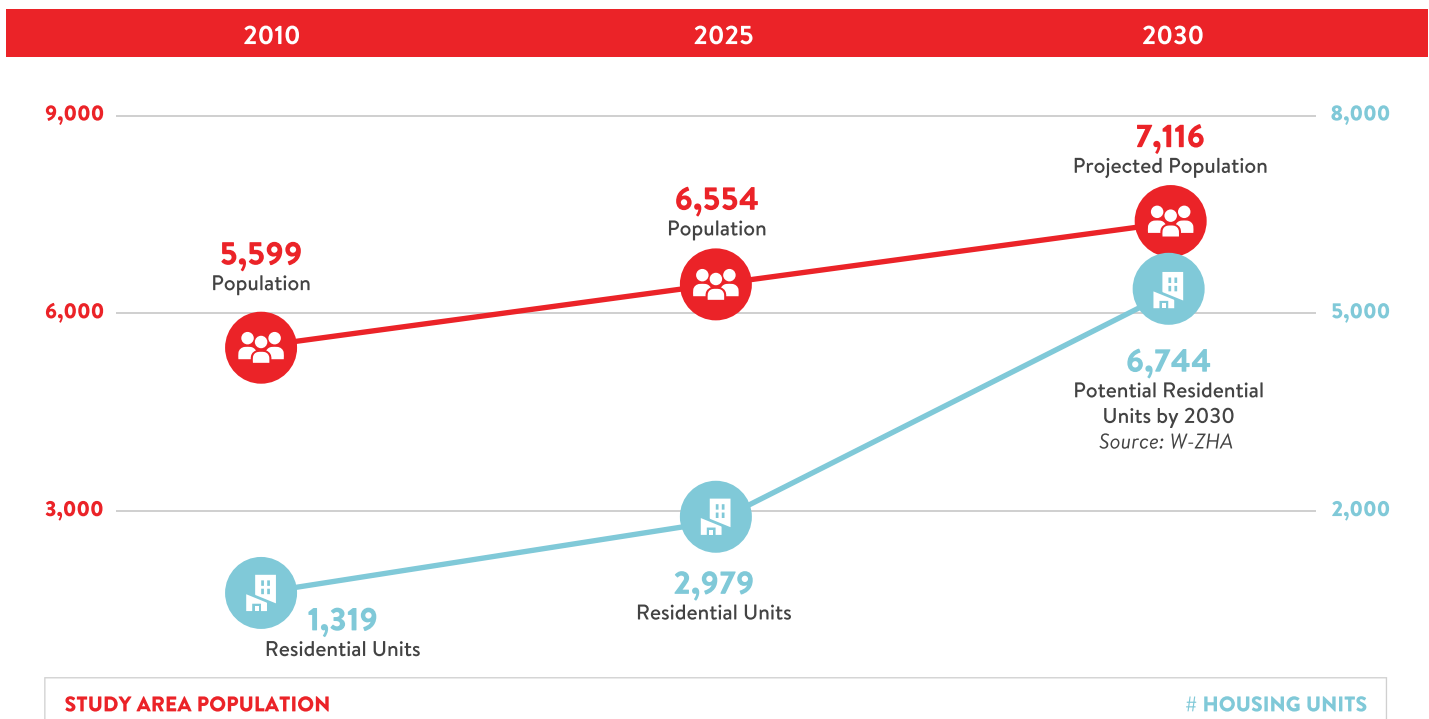
GRANT FROM KANSAS HEALTH FOUNDATION ADDS TO ECONOMIC MOBILITY PLAN

The Partnership is developing a regional strategy to boost economic mobility and prepare a workforce for today and tomorrow. The effort focuses on rewarding work, quality education and opportunity-rich neighborhoods.

- Collaborated with 40+ local stakeholders.
- Studied seven key communities.
- Gathered 100+ ideas from public input and partner interviews.
